



## IMPORTANT Build-up Instructions for Slide

### Vehicle Access Passes are allocated on arrival

The Traffic Management Team has a list of exhibitors and will allocate unloading passes for vehicles as exhibitors or contractors arrive on site.

Access for standbuilding unloading is via the ramp at the rear of Manchester Central. There is no access for unloading at the front of Manchester Central. Where Gt Bridgewater Street meets Lower Mosley Street, turn right and right again up the access ramp. This is not well sign-posted, so keep a sharp look out. ### Contractor/Stand Builder Passes

The Manchester Central Security Team will have a list of exhibitors and will issue wristbands for the build-up period as exhibitors or contractors arrive on site.

### Build Up Schedule:

Please take note of when you are permitted access to dress your stand. If you arrive early, your stand will not be ready and you will have to wait.

Date	Hall Open	Principal Activity
Monday 25 January	1400-1500	Access for Early Action Group only
	1500-2200	Access for space only standbuilders/exhibitors who do not require carpet laid
	1700-2200	Access for space only standbuilders/exhibitors who require carpet to be laid
Tuesday 26 January	0800-2200	Access for space only standbuilders/exhibitors
	1200-2200	Access for shell scheme exhibitors
	2200	All Stands must be completed

NB: Due to the tight build schedule, the official contractors will still be working on supplying electrics to stands on Tuesday afternoon and some of the paint may still be damp on some sites.

### Parking During Open Period of the Show

During the open period of the show there will be limited parking facilities for large vans (larger than transit size) and trucks at the rear of Manchester Central on a first come, first served basis and at the discretion of the Manchester Central Traffic Management team.

Transit vans and cars will not be permitted to park here and will have to use alternative local car parks. #### Directions

**M6 (From South – Stoke-on-Trent, Birmingham)**  
 Leave the M6 at Junction 19, just beyond the Knutsford Services, follow the A556 towards Altrincham and pick up the M56 towards Manchester Airport. Follow motorway onto the A5103 (Princess Parkway) and then signage for Manchester Central, Petersfield.

**M6 (From North – Preston, Blackpool, Carlisle)**  
 Leave the M6 at Junction 21a onto the M62 towards Manchester. At Junction 12, join the M602 and continue to end of the motorway (Regent Road

Roundabout, Salford). Follow City Centre signs along Regent Road and then signage for Manchester Central, Petersfield.

**M62 (From West – Liverpool)**  
 At M62 Junction 12, join the M602 and continue to the end of the motorway (Regent Road Roundabout, Salford). Follow City Centre signs along Regent Road and then signs for Manchester Central, Petersfield.

**M62 (From East – Leeds, Yorkshire)**  
 At M62 Junction 18 join the M60 Westbound. Take M60 Junction 17 onto the A56 (Bury

New Road) and follow signage for City Centre and then for Manchester Central, Petersfield.

**M56 (From West – North Wales, Chester, Ellesmere Port)**  
 Follow the M56 past Manchester Airport, onto the A5103 (Princess Parkway) and then signage for Manchester Central, Petersfield.
